CLASS REMINDERS

-classroom attendance is very important especially as we finish choreography and prepare for the recitals

-continue to follow proper dress code for your class which includes a black leotard and pink tights for students in the 1 hour, 1.25 hour and 1.5 hour classes

-hair should be up in a ponytail or pulled back away from face if too short for ponytail

-students should not be arriving more than 15 minutes early for their class and should not be left in the lobby unsupervised more than 5 minutes before class starts

The office will be closed on picture weekend. All dancers will receive their recital tights, included in their bundle package, prior to picture day.

RECITAL TICKETS

Ticket order forms were already sent home and are due by midnight on April 15 to be included in the first draw. Tickets will be passed out to classes starting April 28. You may not receive your tickets until your account is paid in full.

REHEARSALS

RECITAL VOLUNTEERS

The Manyet Dance recitals are large productions and require the help of many volunteers behind the scenes.

- Women volunteers wait in the dressing room with their child's class until their child's dance and then watch from back stage.
- Volunteers will not be permitted to watch from the back of the auditorium as constant entering and exiting is very distracting to our videographer and audience members.
- We need classroom volunteers, backstage runners and ushers.

Volunteers receive a free registration for **one** student for the 2018-2019 dance year. Volunteers should pick up their signed voucher from the volunteer sign-in table outside of the dressing room area before the show. This is a sign-in for official volunteers *previously* signed up to assist. **This voucher must accompany your registration sheet for the 2018-2019 year to receive one free registration and must be received in our office by July 1.**

PARADES

All dance students age eight and older are invited to dance in the following parades.

- Bellevue Dayton Memorial Day Parade, Monday, May 28, 10:00 AM -no practice necessary
- Ft. Thomas 4th of July Parade on Tuesday, July 4, 10:00 AM - mandatory practice on Tuesday, July 3, 6:00-7:30 PM at the HH studio

Dancers must sign up in the office and order a parade shirt. The same shirt will be worn in both parades and must be ordered ahead of time. You must place your parade t-shirt order with the office by Monday, April 30. The cost of the shirt is \$14. It is the same shirt as last year. For either parade you should wear:

- Manyet red/camo performance parade shirt
- plain white shorts
- plain white tennis shoes
- plain white socks
- light makeup
- hair in a high ponytail.

SPRING & SUMMER CLASSES
